NOTICE TO PORT OF PORTLAND TARIFF USERS  
RE: REVISION TO PORT TARIFF NO. 7 – EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007

**Section 1 – Miscellaneous Rate Tables:**

The following item description has changed:

1040.010 – Security identification card fee  
Added text of “(Port Issued security card)”

The following item is a new charge accessed for rail storage and or track rental:

1200.100 – Rail Storage and or Track Rental. The charge is \$0.55 per L/F month.

**Section 2 – Dockage Rules and Rates:**

The following item description has changed:

205.0 – Dockage Charge – Vessels on Lay Status  
Replaced Operations Manager with “Operations General Manager or their designee”

The following item is a new charge accessed for late receipt of Statement of Facts, billing information or late request for lay status.

2010.000 – Billing/Rebilling Fee. The charge is \$250.00

**Section 3 - Breakbulk Rules and Rates:**

The following items have increased approximately 3%:

3050.251 - Liquid Bulks  
3300.321 - NOS Wharfage

**Section 4 – Container Cargo Rules and Rate Tables:**

The following items have increased approximately 3%:

4000.000 – Container Throughput  
4010.000 - Transshipped Containers (Stevedoring)  
4050.000 – Vessel Rehandling (Cell-To-Cell Rehandles)  
4060.000 – Cell-to-Dock-to-Cell or Dock-to-Cell-to-Dock  
4070.000 – Surcharge for Over Height/Overwidth Containers  
4100.000 – Wharfage

One exception is item 4000.520 – Vessel Stevedoring -Third Shift  
Increased from \$210.00 to \$227.00

The following items have increased:

- 4321.810 – Yard rehandling – Full/Empty or Chassis  
Increased from \$49.00 to \$59.00.
- 4322.805 – Late Gate Charge  
Increased from \$145.00 to \$225.00
- 4322.810 – Overtime Gate Surcharge for weekend, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> shifts  
Increased from single per container charge of \$120.00 to tier pricing of \$151.00  
containers 1 -40 count and then \$75.00 for over 40 count.
- 4322.820 – Overtime Gate Surcharge for Monday – Friday Day shift ILWU Holiday Gate  
Increased from \$20.00 to \$21.00.
- 4323.815 – Rolled Container Fee after terminal cutoff  
Increased from \$90.00 to \$105.00.
- 4370.824 – Rail Carrier – Intermodal Yard Facility Fee – Rail Lift  
Increased from \$18.50 to \$19.00.
- 4410.850 – Weekend and 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift Barge Operations – Surcharge – Full or Empty  
Containers  
Decrease from \$44.00 to \$20.00.
- 4800.882 – Inspection of Containers  
Increased from \$32.00 to \$44.00
- 4802.886 – Container Fumigation “Set Aside”  
Increased from \$27.00 to \$118.00.

The following section has been deleted:

- 4600.000 – Container Chassis Services and Repairs Miscellaneous Related Services  
Includes 4600.00 – Container/Chassis Repairs through  
4600.865 – Steam Clean 40-ft Container.

### **Section 6 – Longshore Labor Services:**

The following items have been adjusted or increased:

- 6500.0 – Security Officers Minimum 4-hours pay. All shifts are now charged \$60.00.  
6530.0 – Electrician. Increased all shifts by 3.4%.  
6540.0 - Other Crafts. Increased all shifts by 3.4%.

### **Section 7 – Equipment Rate Tables:**

The following item is a new charge:

- 7250.700 – Top Loaders / Reach Stackers  
\$247.00 per hour.
