1 **MEETING CALL TO ORDER**

2
3 The meeting was called to order by chair David King.

4
5 **ANNOUNCEMENTS/REVIEW & APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MONTH'S MEETING SUMMARY/ADDITIONS TO**
6 **THE AGENDA**

7
8 There were no changes or additions to the meeting summary from the October 2005 meeting.
9 A motion was made by Fred Hostetler to accept the summary as written. The motion was
10 seconded and passed.

11
12 Major Paul Fitzgerald of the Oregon Air National Guard announced to the committee that he is
13 leaving his position on the committee due to a change in his position at the Air Guard. He then
14 introduced his replacement, Major Jeff Hwang, who will represent the ORANG at future CNAC
15 meetings.

16
17 Steve Twohey introduced Chris Blair, the Port's new Noise Planner within the Noise
18 Management Department. He further announced that Bob Turner, formerly of the Noise
19 Management Department, has been promoted to a new position within the Port and will,
20 therefore, no longer be sitting on the committee.

21
22 Rachel Wray announced that Paul Dunholter, from BridgeNet International, will be presenting at
23 the Land Use Advisory Committee in December. He will be speaking about aircraft noise
24 analyses related to PDX development scenarios.

26 **PRESENTATION/GUEST SPEAKER – CHRIS CORICH**

27
28 Mr. Corich gave a briefing on the cargo feeder issue. He began by introducing committee
29 members from the cargo feeder task force in attendance. Those members include Dave Smith,
30 Maryhelen Kincaid, Fred Stovel, Mike Yee, Jo Smith, and Laura Schneider. Also in attendance
31 were Maria Thi Mai from the office of Commissioner Sam Adams and Russ Polosun of Empire
32 Air.

33
34 Mr. Corich told the committee that there will be a joint meeting with CNAC and the cargo feeder
35 ad hoc committee January 12th, at which time a "hand off" of the work done by the ad hoc
36 committee will be turned over to CNAC.

37
38 He reminded the committee that the cargo feeder ad hoc committee was formed because of
39 questions raised during the Part 150 study. In response to those questions, the Port
40 Commission asked the Noise office to further study the issue of cargo feeder flights.

41
42 Topics addressed in Mr. Corich's presentation included:

44 o Regional cargo feeder fly day data summary
45 o Legal flight altitudes
46 o Aircraft Operating 12 a.m. – 6 a.m. on the busiest day of the year (June 30, 2005)
47 o Operations by hour for the busiest day of the year (June 30, 2005)
48 o Operations by hour for the busiest day of the year (August 16, 1996)
49 o Comparison – Operations by hour 2005 vs. 1996
50 o Potential scenarios
51 o Potential scenario graphics – east flow arrivals
52 o Potential scenario graphics – east flow departures

- 53 o Potential scenario graphics – west flow arrivals
- 54 o Potential scenario graphics – west flow departures

56 Laura Schneider of the FAA then reviewed the regional cargo feeder ad hoc committee
57 principles and recommendations with CNAC. A resultant recommendation came from
58 Vancouver representative Mike Yee. He suggested that before the recommendations are
59 formally presented for approval, an informed representative from Vancouver be included in all
60 final meetings to ensure balanced view points.

61

62 Mr. Corich summarized by saying that when the CNAC and ad hoc committees meet in January,
63 he believes both committees should be seated at the head table, demonstrating equal
64 representation.

66 **SELECTION OF NEW CNAC CHAIRPERSON – DAVID KING**

67

68 David King advised the committee that he is stepping down as chair of CNAC at the end of
69 2005. He said the committee, therefore, should select a new chairperson. It was also decided
70 a new vice-chair needs to be selected as well.

71

72 After discussion, a vote was taken to elect a chair and vice chair person. The vote resulted in
73 Maryhelen Kincaid as chair and Dave Smith as vice-chair effective January 2006.

75 **AIRPORT NOISE REPORT (ANR)**

76

77 Erwin Bergman discussed Volume 17, Number 28, of the ANR, which addresses hushkit
78 aircraft, and requested the Noise Office research which airlines utilize hushkit technology at
79 PDX. Mr. Corich supported the request, saying the Noise office will do the requested research
80 and provide CNAC with the results.
