22 **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

24 Ann Bonner, Wilkes community member, addressed the committee. She is requesting the Port
25 remember they (the Wilkes community) are asking for help from the Port regarding cargo feeder
26 aircraft noise. She stated the cargo feeder aircraft fly over Wilkes from 11 pm to 6 am every
27 day.

28
29 Theresa Delany-Davis, also from Wilkes community, spoke to the committee regarding cargo
30 feeder aircraft noise. She said although it is still a major topic of concern, people who live in the
31 Wilkes community have become silent about their concerns because they believe they have
32 become "outmaneuvered and buried under paper work..." and that they are fighting battles they
33 cannot win.

35 Theresa asked that further studies be done in the Wilkes community for cargo feeder noise
36 issues. It has been, and still is, her recommendation that the cargo feeder aircraft be moved six
37 (6) blocks so they fly over the industrial area.

39 Maria Thi Mai, liaison to commission Sam Adams, introduced herself and shared that she and
40 Mr. Adams are both very interested in noise issues. She and Mr. Adams are working with the
41 Port of Portland toward some type of resolution to the cargo feeder issue.

43 **PART 150 STUDY AND CARGO FEEDER ISSUE UPDATE**

45 Steve Twohey informed the committee that the Part 150 study has been sent to the FAA and it
46 is being reviewed.

48 Steve reported that the next meeting for the cargo feeder ad hoc committee is Tuesday,
49 October 18th at the downtown Port building, 4 pm to 7 pm. Options presented by the FAA will
50 be discussed at that meeting.

52 **AIRPORT NOISE REPORT (ANR)**

54 It was decided that the ANR should remain on the agenda even though there is not always
55 discussion about the latest publications.

57 **BUSINESS NOT ON THE AGENDA**

59 David King informed the committee that he is planning on stepping down as chairman at the end
60 of 2005. He plans to continuing sitting on the committee, but will no longer act as chair after
61 December. He suggested that the Port begin their search for a Multnomah County
62 representative that can step in when he vacates his position on the committee in December,
63 2006.
