42 **ANOMS 8 UPDATE– CHRIS BLAIR**

44 Chris gave a brief update on the ANOMS-8 project and shared “screen shots” of the

45 system with the committee.

- 47 • Sample screen shots included flight track data, flight tracks depicted over a
- 48 number of base maps including an aerial photograph.
- 49 • Users will be able to view flight track and operations data via the internet.
- 50 • Military and law enforcement operations will be filtered out per National
- 51 requirements.

52 **MILITARY AND OTHER SPECIAL EVENTS REPORT – JASON SCHWARTZ**

54 The City of Vancouver again this year requested a special flight diversion for July 19  
55 during the outdoor concert of the Vancouver symphony. There noise complaints related  
56 to this event.

58 Additionally, we received a request from ORANG for overhead approach flights on  
59 August 8<sup>th</sup> and July 10<sup>th</sup>. No complaints related to these operations were received.

61 **FUTURE INFORMATIONAL REPORTS – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

63 The committee discussed the benefit of the current complaint reports. Because of the  
64 complexity of this report, the Noise staff is looking at changing the report entirely. While  
65 a few members appreciate the current reporting method, samples of potential reports  
66 were shared with the committee who will review and let staff know their preferences.

68 It was expressed that flight tracks showing actual complaint origins would be preferred –  
69 “better maps.” ANOMS-8 will be able to provide a “box” with a number within it  
70 indicating the number of complaints from a specific area.

72 **NOISE OFFICE REPORT – JASON SCHWARTZ**

73

74 Update on the Part 150; the Record of Approval has been received; 27 of 29  
75 recommendations were approved; the Noise office is proceeding with plans for  
76 implementation of the approved recommendations. FAA disapproved the  
77 recommendations on sound insulation for floating homes and aircraft propeller retrofits.

79 Jason spoke to the committee regarding the request from CNAC to have a guest  
80 speaker to address what is being done in the field of aircraft manufacturing and the  
81 building of quieter aircraft. The Port has invited Boeing to speak at the October meeting  
82 on this topic, as well as the new 787 technology. Boeing has accepted our invitation and  
83 will be giving a two hour presentation at the Gresham meeting. The presentation will  
84 take up the bulk of the October meeting.

86 **NEIGHBORHOOD REPORTS, AIRPORT NOISE REPORT, NEXT MEETING’S AGENDA AND**  
87 **COMMITTEE BRAINSTORMING – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

89 Maryhelen reminded the committee of the commitment to provide an annual report to the  
90 Port Commission regarding the work the committee has been done. It was decided  
91 Maryhelen will attend the November Commission meeting and give a report.

93 There being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting. The motion  
94 was seconded and passed. Meeting adjourned.
