1 **MEETING CALL TO ORDER**

2  
3 Meeting was called to order by chair Maryhelen Kincaid.

4  
5 **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF OCTOBER MEETING SUMMARY – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

7 The October meeting summary was approved as written.

8  
9 **CARGO FEEDER UPDATE – JASON SCHWARTZ**

10  
11 Jason provided an update on the cargo feeder project by reviewing recommendations  
12 that were made by the citizen groups/committees that worked on the project. He then  
13 turned the floor over to Ava Frank who gave a presentation about the study and  
14 implementation history for the cargo feeder project. The presentation consisted of the  
15 following:

17 § Citizen Recommendations and the research done in response to each  
18 § Previous flight conditions detailing the flight paths of the aircraft  
19 § Testing methodology  
20 § Arrival dispersion and altitude comparisons  
21 § Departure dispersion and altitude comparisons  
22 § Next steps

24 **FOOTPRINT FOR PDX OVER THE PAST 20+ YEARS – GREGG MAXWELL**

25  
26 The fleet-mix history of PDX - where we are now compared to where we were 20+ years  
27 ago and how these changes affect the PDX noise impacts was presented by Gregg  
28 Maxwell. His presentation included information about how have aircraft operations and  
29 airline fleet mixes have changed at PDX over the last 3+ decades and how this has  
30 changed the noise impacts to residential communities surrounding PDX.

34 **JURISDICTIONAL REPORTS – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

35  
36 Maryhelen discussed the Jurisdictional Report template which was emailed to CNAC  
37 members and asked they be completed and copies sent to both Debbie Bishop and  
38 each person's jurisdiction. The intent of the template is to help facilitate communication  
39 between CNAC members and the appointing jurisdictions.

41 **2008 PLANNING MEETING DISCUSSION (DATES, LOCATIONS) – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

42  
43 Maryhelen asked the committee for preferences on dates for the planning meeting this  
44 year. The dates currently under consideration are January 26 and February 2, 2008.  
45 The planning meeting (formerly known as the "retreat") will be held in Vancouver.  
46 Members will check their availability and let Shannon Huggins know which of the dates  
47 works best for them.

49 Additionally, Maryhelen asked members to forward discussion topics to Shannon so she  
50 can prepare an agenda.

53 **NOISE MANAGEMENT REPORT REVIEW - PROJECT UPDATES, UPCOMING MEETINGS**  
54 **AND EVENTS – JASON SCHWARTZ/NOISE TEAM**

56 Jason reported that the Noise Management team is in the process of prioritizing the  
57 recommendations approved by FAA and developing an implementation plan.

58 Additionally, the Fly Quiet program is moving forward and the team will be selecting a  
59 consultant to assist with next steps in program development.

61 The HIO open house had over 300 attendees and was a great success. There will be  
62 additional operator and community outreach efforts in the near future, such as an Airport  
63 Futures open house on the 10<sup>th</sup> at PDX and a second one on the 13<sup>th</sup> in Vancouver at  
64 Hudson Bay High School.

66 A request for an overhead approach was submitted by ORANG. After input from CNAC,  
67 the Port gave an initial approval of the request and forwarded to FAA for final approval.
