1 **MEETING CALL TO ORDER**

3 Meeting was called to order by chair Maryhelen Kincaid.

5 **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF JANUARY MEETING SUMMARY – MARYHELEN KINCAID**

7 The January meeting summary was approved as written.

8
9 **ANOMS 8 PROJECT UPDATE – CHRIS BLAIR**

11 Chris Blair demonstrated WebTrak, a web application that will allow the public to
12 view aircraft flight track activity via the internet in the near future. Chris also gave
13 a demonstration on ANOMS-8, the Noise Management Department's upgraded
14 Noise and Operations Monitoring System, by using it to run through a
15 hypothetical citizen complaint, investigation, and response scenario.

17 **NEW OVERHEAD APPROACH PATTERN – LT. COL. JEFF HWANG, ORANG**

18
19 Lt. Col. Jeffery Hwang described a proposal to modify the current Overhead-
20 Break pattern which will change the turning pattern from the south to the north on
21 final approach. This change would result in F-15 aircraft overflying airport
22 property and the Columbia River, rather than residential areas in Northeast
23 Portland.

25 Specific issues covered in Lt. Col. Hwang's presentation included:

- 27 • Runway 28L Approach Altitude
 - 28 • Runway 28L Overhead Altitude
 - 29 • 28L Overhead Pattern
 - 30 • 10 R Overhead Pattern
 - 31 • Advantages and Disadvantages

33 CNAC member Gary Thornton expressed concerns with shifting noise from
34 Portland to Vancouver. Following a group discussion, CNAC recommended the
35 Port move forward with an investigation/analysis of the procedure and to discuss
36 it further in the future.

38 **CNAC ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR 2007 – JASON SCHWARTZ/MARYHELEN KINCAID**

40 The jurisdictional reports have been tabled until the March 22 Planning Session.
41 Other topics the committee requested updates on the current status of the Part
42 150. Schwartz reported the FAA has approved the Part 150 and the Port is in
43 the process of developing implementation plans for the approved
44 recommendations. Other topics of interest included the latest EIS study;
45 airspace redesign, study of pending litigation regarding noise and environmental
46 protections acts being looked at in other states.

51 Vicki reported that the PAG is now on meeting number five (5) and things are
52 moving a bit more slowly than she had hoped they would be by this time. Some
53 subcommittee groups have been formed, but overall, work is going slowly. She
