58 Shannon reported she spoke to Chris Blair, manager of the ANOMS project and it is
59 “moving along” and the team is very optimistic regarding web track – it should be online
60 in the near future. The analysis using ANOMS is working well and the team is very
61 excited about the capabilities of the program.

63 Shannon introduced our new Noise Office intern Erica Muse.

65 We are almost done with the process of selecting a consultant for the fly quiet program
66 and will let CNAC know who that consultant is as soon as they are selected. Any future
67 opportunities for in-depth involvement by CNAC members to work with the Port on the fly
68 quiet program will be identified through work with the consultant and the Noise
69 management team.

71 Shannon reminded members of the February 2 winter planning meeting at the
72 Heathman Lodge in Vancouver. Directions and address information will be mailed to
73 each member prior to the meeting. The meeting time was originally scheduled for noon
74 to 4 pm however it was requested the length of the meeting be extended so we agreed
75 to start the meeting at 11 a.m. pending confirmation with the Lodge. Shannon then
76 reviewed what topics will be covered at the planning meeting.

78 Maryhelen told the committee that she had requested Shannon be the facilitator at the
79 planning meeting so she has the opportunity to participate as a committee member.
